[The Friends of St. Clement's Bay](#), a new watershed organization serving the basins of St. Clement's Bay and Breton Bay, last weekend launched the Marylanders Grows Oysters program and distributed more than 100 cages containing 24 bushels of spat-on-shell. SMWRA partnered with FOCSB last summer to build more than 600 cages for local volunteers in the MGO program.
