



Our 2022 Recruitment Study Results





For the past five years (since 2018), we have conducted an oyster reproduction success (recruitment) survey throughout the tidal St. Mary's River. We are happy to report that 2022 had the highest spatfall out of all study years. Results of this study help inform fishery management and watermen, who need to make tough choices of where to invest monies to maximize harvests. Thanks to our volunteers, student interns, Maryland Department of Natural Resources, and Cove Point Natural Heritage Trust for their support on this project.
