This year, *A River Affair* will be held on **Sunday, April 7**. Purchase your tickets today to enjoy frosty libations, great food, and unique auction items.

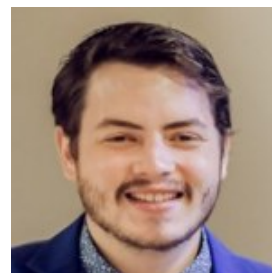
